Visiting Policy: You are welcome to visit your child's classes. Please make arrangements with the principal and teacher prior to your visit. While in the building, please stop by the front office first. Please enter through the front doors located by the front office. All other doors will remain locked for the day.

Damaged/Lost Items: Students will be charged for damaged or lost school owned books or supplies.

Field Trips: Field trips are scheduled during the year to enhance the students learning experiences. On some trips, parents are invited to help chaperone the students. If you are interested in becoming a chaperone for a field trip, please contact you child's teacher.

Gum & Candy: No gum is permitted at any time. Candy and other food items, cupcakes, ice cream, etc. are limited to parties and other special occasions. You must submit a request to bring in additional food items to your child's classroom teacher.

Toys & Electronics: Students are discouraged from bringing these to school! The school will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged toys, electronics, and other personal possessions brought from home.

Appropriate Clothing: 1) Shoes must be worn at all times! 2) Wearing apparel that is unclean, unhealthy, or unsafe is not permitted (includes clothing that is too large). 3) Students must be fully clothed, meaning bare midriffs and other improperly exposed skin are prohibited. 4) Halter tops and shoulder straps (spaghetti straps) are not allowed. 5) Students should not wear coats or jackets in the classrooms without teacher and parent permission. 6) Students are not permitted to wear hats, other head coverings, sunglasses, or headbands without specific administrative permission. 7) Students are not allowed to display pictures on clothing which supports or advertises tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, gangs and symbols that are illegal, immoral, and socially objectionable such as violence, blood, killing, death, or sex.
